Most of their flavorings are un-processed and are simply dried, shaved or pureed from their natural state. All of the milk is sourced from dairy farms that pledge not to use rBGH (Bovine Growth Hormone) or other growth hormones on their cows located within 45 miles of our plant in Boulder, Colorado.

- RMIFT Scholarships & Travel Grants -

It's time to start thinking about fulfilling scholarship and travel grant requirements. With the support of its industry members, this year the RMIFT is proud to offer two (2) \$1500 scholarships and four (4) \$750 travel grants. If you are studying Animal Science, Culinary Arts, Food Science, Nutrition, or another food related field, you are eligible to receive a scholarship or grant. Undergraduate or graduate students are welcome to apply.

- RMIFT Educational Scholarships -

In a continuing effort to support future professionals in the food industry, the RMIFT is awarding two (2) \$1500 scholarships to qualified students.
