### Directions

#### *FROM DENVER*

Take I-25 North to US 36 West. Travel on US 36 for approximately 20-25 miles. As you see the outskirts of Boulder approaching, exit onto Highway 157 (Foothills Parkway) heading north. Highway 157 will turn into Highway 119 heading northeast. Travel northeast on Highway 119 (Longmont diagonal) to Jay Road. Turn right, east, on Jay Road. Travel 1 mile on Jay Road to Spine Road. Turn left, north, on Spine Road. Travel 1/2 mile on Spine Road. Turn left, west, onto Sleepytime Drive.

#### *FROM BOULDER*

Take Highway 119 (Longmont diagonal) heading northeast. Turn right, east, on Jay Road. Travel 1 mile on Jay Road to Spine Road. Turn left, north, on Spine Road. Travel 1/2 mile on Spine Road. Turn left, west, onto Sleepytime Drive.

Laurie Scanlin, a doctoral candidate and student at CSU working with Dr. Martha Stone in the Department of Food Science and Human Nutrition, participated in the Student Division Product Development Competition sponsored by the American Association of Cereal Chemists. She won first place in the overall competition at the national conference held in Portland, Oregon. Her product is Mother's Grain, an all natural, instant rice cereal fortified with quinoa protein isolate and naturally sweetened with bananas. Included in the competition was a written report, oral presentation with questions from a 3-member panel from the food industry, poster exhibit, and product presentation for evaluation by the panel of judges. Laurie received certificates from the President of AACC for best poster and best product along with the \$1000 Grand Prize. In addition, her picture and announcement of the award will be featured in an upcoming issue of Cereal Foods World. Teams comprised of 3 graduate students each from Texas A&M and Chapman University won second and third place, respectively, in the competition. Congratulations Laurie!
